Community Input session to discuss ESSER relief funds

Erin School District Community Input session to discuss ESSER relief funds. The American Rescue Plan, the third federal COVID-19 relief law, passed in March 2021. This legislation provides one-time funds for Erin School District through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) III grant program. The grant application process includes several required steps the Erin School District must complete to receive ESSER III funds.

Erin School needs the community's help! Please share your ideas at this meeting to help Erin School District determine programs and services that may benefit from these funds, which must meet the criterion outlined by the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) to qualify as Evidence-Based Improvement Strategies.
